

## ***Adventure Work Crew***

NorthBay functions with a small adventure staff during our weekends. In order to keep the camp costs low for our weekend user groups, we request that each user group provide “adventure work crew” (typically 2 volunteers per activity you would like open, depending on the size of your group and number of groups on camp) to assist our staff in facilitating the different adventure elements.

If you desire to have the ropes course, zip line, climbing wall, giant swing and waterfront open (seasonal), then it is essential to provide these volunteers. If you cannot provide these volunteers to assist in this area, then NorthBay will result in limiting certain adventure elements due to lack of people to run it safely.

You will not be charged for these adventure work staff. Although no experience is necessary for these volunteers; they should be physically capable individuals, over the age of 18, prepared to work outside for 5 hours or longer and dressed appropriately based on the weather. All work crew will need to wear close-toed shoes.

Depending on your group’s schedule, it may be possible for the adventure work crew to attend most of the meetings that you’ve planned unlike the dining hall work crew. It is expected to have adventure work crew available to work whenever the adventure activities are open.

A typical weekend might look like the following for someone on adventure work crew:

### ***Friday***

Upon arrival, it is the responsibility of the camp manager to introduce the adventure work crew with the Guest Services host on duty for the night. The Guest Services host will explain the parameters of the adventure work crew responsibilities for the weekend. The group’s schedule will determine when the adventure work crew will be working.

### ***Saturday***

Following Saturday breakfast, adventure work crew will be trained by a NorthBay adventure staff member on the use of our adventure elements. A NorthBay adventure staff member will be with your adventure work crew during the activities to answer questions and respond to potential issues.

In special cases, the adventure work crew may be asked to assist in other areas such as maintenance, food service, guest services or housekeeping during free time.

### ***Sunday***

Prior to departure, it is the adventure work crew’s responsibility to clean the room that been occupied for the weekend by removing trash and stripping and separating the linens.
